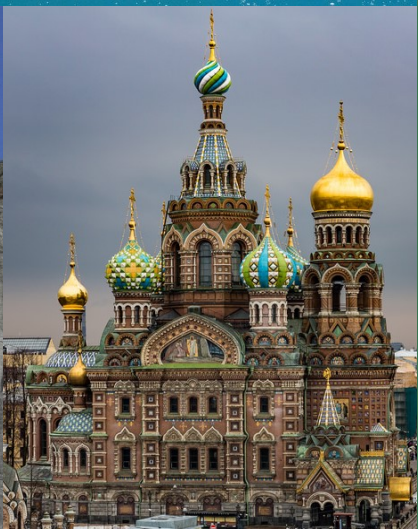

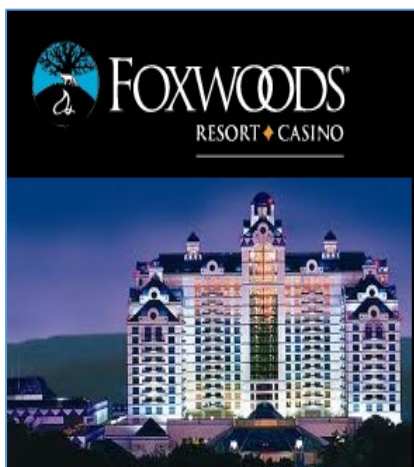

# PHILADELPHIA FLOWER SHOW

3 Days / March 2 – 4 (Saturday – Monday)



The PHS Philadelphia Flower Show is an annual event at the Pennsylvania Convention Center put on by the Pennsylvania Horticulture Society in March. It is the world's oldest and largest indoor flower show, attracting more than 250,000 people annually. The Show features large-scale gardens, elaborate landscapes, and over-the-top floral creations. Visitors to the Philadelphia Flower Show are treated to fabulous design, live entertainment, culinary

demonstrations, gardening how-to workshops, and lectures by experts. Proceeds from the Show support PHS, particularly the City Harvest program, which feeds more than 1,200 families each week during the growing seasons.

You should have a chance to admire some amazing gardens Saturday after arrival but don't rush, you have a two day ticket. Not included in the tour package but happening that night if you have interest is a Beatles Tribute band performing amongst the gardens. Sunday morning will include a tour of historic Philadelphia where you will see the liberty bell and Independence Hall and learn the history of our country's founding in the rooms where it happened. That afternoon return to the flower show and then meet back up for a group dinner at an Italian restaurant.

**GRATUITIES:** Gratuities can be awkward for many people. For your convenience Vermont's Green Mountain Tours, LLC will provide gratuity envelopes in your pre-tour package. A guideline for tipping your Tour Director and Driver is \$5.00 PER PERSON, PER DAY. LOCAL STEP ON GUIDE IS \$3.00 PER DAY.

**RESERVATIONS:** Reservations can be made via phone, email, our website, or in person. Plan early to avoid going on a wait list.

**PAYMENTS:** For one-day tours, full payment is due with your reservation. For multi-day tours there is a deposit of 20% per person, unless a higher amount is specified. The due date for the balance will be announced on the bill. We accept check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card, Diners Card, JCB, or Union Pay. All tour prices subject to change.

**PASSENGERS WITH DISABILITIES:** Passengers requiring special care and/or assistance must notify us of their particular needs at the time of booking. While we would be pleased to try to accommodate the special needs of disabled passengers with the means presently available to us, we may not be able to do so for safety, health, or other reasons. If you require assistance you must have an able travel companion. Passengers must provide their own special equipment, such as wheel chairs, oxygen, etc.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** There will be an administrative fee of \$50.00 per person for cancellations. Plus the cost of the tickets, transportation, meals & lodging. Once tickets/admissions are purchased on behalf of travelers, they become non-refundable and/or are subject to name-change fees by the airline if a suitable replacement is found. Vermont's Green Mountain Tours, as your agent, commits to tickets, transportation, meals and lodging, and many are non-refundable. Refunds will be issued approximately 4-6 weeks after the trip. We strongly recommend travelers insurance as protection in case of need to cancel. Please call us to arrange for this insurance.

## **IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT TRAVELER'S INSURANCE:**

1. You must purchase the insurance no later than two days prior to departure.



2. MEDICARE DOES NOT cover expenses incurred outside the United States. Please check directly with your supplemental insurance company to find out if that company will cover those expenses. Typically, a temporary rider is used to cover unforeseen medical emergencies while out of the country.
3. Our travel insurance DOES cover medical costs, including preexisting conditions.
4. Trip cancellation/delay coverage must fall under the following conditions: Loss of wallet, passport, quarantine, hijacking, civil disorder, natural disaster, weather (documented by airlines), or airline strike

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** The per person tour cost is going to be lower as the number of people in the room increases. Therefore the rate for a single room is higher than the rate for a quad (4 people per room). Single rooms are limited. Triple and quad rooms usually have two double beds. Vermont's Green Mountain Tours, LLC does not arbitrarily room persons together. Passengers must select their own roommates.

**CHILD DISCOUNT:** Children 12 years old and younger will receive a discount of 10% off the applicable rate while they share the same room with their parents. Child must be 12 years or younger at the time of trip, and proof of age is required within five days of reservation.

**BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE & LIABILITY:** Baggage service is provided for some of our tours, but not all. Each person is allowed one large suitcase and one carry-on. The carry-on is to be handled by the traveler, who will assume full responsibility for it. Please mark all baggage with your name, address and phone number. Vermont's Green Mountain Tours will provide luggage tags for your larger bag. Vermont's Green Mountain Tours cannot assume liability for damaged or lost baggage. Insurance is recommended. On multi-day tours, carry-on bags must be stowed in the cargo bay under the bus. Travelers will be responsible for transporting these bags to and from the hotel.

**DEPARTURE TIMES & PICK UP POINTS:** Vermont's Green Mountain Tours is not responsible for your automobile in the parking lot. All parking is at your own risk and/or expense. If you decide to change your pick up point, it is important to let us know in advance. Our departure time is indicated on itinerary. In fairness to other passengers we cannot wait for someone who is late therefore we ask that you arrive fifteen minutes prior to the scheduled departure time. Departure times are subject to change and you will be notified of any changes prior to the tour. Pick up locations are subject to change based on demographics of our guests.

**EVENTS CHANGES:** If an event such as a show or baseball game is cancelled due to weather or anything else that is beyond our control, Vermont's Green Mountain Tours cannot be held responsible for ticket refunds. Travel insurance does cover this expense.

**SMOKING & ALCOHOL:** Smoking is not permitted on the coach. There will be rest stops to accommodate those who wish to smoke. Alcohol is prohibited on board all motor coaches.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** All rates are subject to change. Vermont's Green Mountain Tours, LLC reserves the right by its sole discretion to make changes in itineraries and is not responsible to any person for expense, loss of time, money, or other circumstances resulting from a change in itinerary or change of tour arrangement. Vermont's Green Mountain Tours, LLC is not responsible for other services, loss, injury or damage to any person or property however caused, or for any delays, extra expenses or inconveniences caused by weather, acts of God or passenger deviations.

**WEATHER POLICY:** Vermont's Green Mountain Tours' weather policy is "we travel unless roads are closed." That means rain, snow, sleet, or hail, the tour normally goes!

**INTERNATIONAL (INCLUDING CANADA) BORDER REQUIREMENTS:** U.S. Citizens are required to present an enhanced driver's license, passport, passport card, or naturalization papers. Non U.S. Citizens must have a valid Passport or Alien Card. Regular Driver's License is NOT proof of citizenship, but may be requested as additional ID. Boarding without sufficient I.D. will not warrant a refund.

**NEW PASSPORT REGULATIONS:** As of June 1, 2009, all persons, including U.S. citizens, traveling between the U.S. and Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean or Bermuda by land or sea ports-of-entry (including ferries), will be required to present a valid passport, passport card or Enhanced Driver's License as determined by the Department of Homeland Security. You should take action at least three to four months prior to departure if you need your first or a renewed passport. Check your current passport, noting the date that it expires, so that you can plan in plenty of time to replace it. Passports are valid for 10 years.

**PASSPORT CARD:** The State Department has issued this passport card in response to the needs of border resident communities for a less expensive and more portable alternative to the traditional passport book. The card has the same period of validity as a passport book: ten years for an adult, five for children fifteen and younger. Adults who already have a fully valid passport book may apply for the card as a passport renewal.
